# GOVERNMENT UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOL CHIRWA GIRLS

## Saturday, October 10, 2015

URVASHI and ANANDA were invited by Sandhya Solanki Professor to visit his school in Chirwa. They are mounted in the teachers with Prasad taxi driver. 20 km in the mountains to arrive in the village. The children were all sitting on the ground praying, they sat in front of them. They were very concentrated. Then they visited each class, in all 8.

Class 1 of Sarika	23 students	Class 5 of Sandhya	28 students
Class 2 of Bharti	16 students	Class 6 of Anita	18 students
Class 3 of Manju	23 students	Class 7 of Madhu	16 students
Class 4 of Lata	24 students	Class 8 of Asha	6 students

Asha is the administrator of the school and 'Headmistress'. There are 154 students in all. The Government gives for meal flour, lenses and a fruit per week to children. Durga and Manju make 200 chappatis and 3 kilos and a half lenses per day to feed the 154 students.

Meal of the week.

Monday: lenses, chappatis.

Tuesday: curry rice.

Wednesday: lentils and roast.

Thursday: kachori.

Friday: lentils and roast.

Saturday: vegetables and roasted.

Students begin the course at 9:20 and end at 3:40. They take a break at 12:45 for lunch outside classes.

The teachers were happy, they have sung, they made the alphabet, they have shared moments of emotions, they were treated to tea.

Prasad gave them back in his taxi, they returned happy this Saturday morning.

## Friday, October 16, 2015

URVASHI and ANANDA return with the banner and 160 fruits of our NGO. They have been still received with open arms, they have distributed fruit during the meal and then they have made a leap in another school three kilometres KARALO KA GURA, then returned to the small school. They did participate in all children games and songs and they left at 3:30 very happy of their day. Our team is invited to come once a month by the Director.

## Saturday, November 21, 2015

They returned to school Govt Girls Chiwa UPS, accompanied by Mr Shaym Sunder Dasora and Mr Om Prakash Lohar, to make a distribution of school supplies for an amount of **3500 ₹**.

Upon their arrival, the children awaited them sitting on three stored on mats on either side of the school. They started the distribution and gave each a slate, felts, a notebook, a pencil and eraser children were very happy.

URVASHI and ANANDA organized a drawing competition for next month. Let the best person win!

**Saturday, December 5, 2015**

Artistic day... A design competition was launched in all classes.

Sports day... All the school children participated in the competition of the games organised by URVASHI and ANANDA. It was a great day of joy and friendship. Each child received a small gift for his participation.

### **Winter holidays**

During the winter holidays, 5, 7 and 9 January, we have been to Chirwa Govt Girls Upper Primary School team with Mrs Sandhya SOLANKI and Mr Prasad MENARIA to restore, decorate and clean this little school.

1 ° day... Ananda sealed and restored the exterior of the kitchen door and joined Urvashi who decorated the towers of doors, windows, pillars and the tables in the company of Sandhya and Prasad who were following the directions.

2 ° day... while each decorated, others chipped trees and cleaned the Court, not to mention the small repairs on faucets.

3 ° day... a beautiful clock was painted on the wall with wooden children's mobile needle and other drawings focused on visual materials. The pleasure has been immense for everyone and a team of children joined we finally cleaned the Court and taking care of trees pruned. They were ten with their trash to pick up papers, plastics and the rocks that littered the floor of the playground. They were very brave.

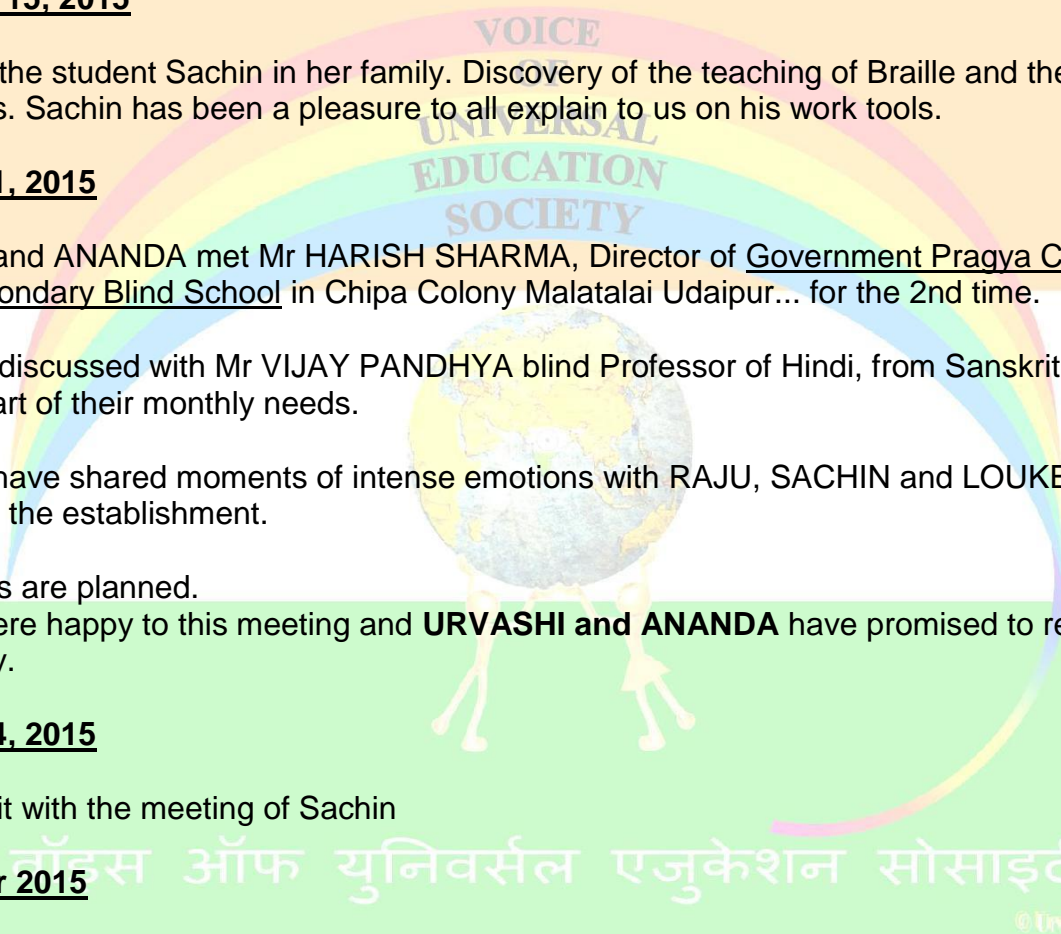

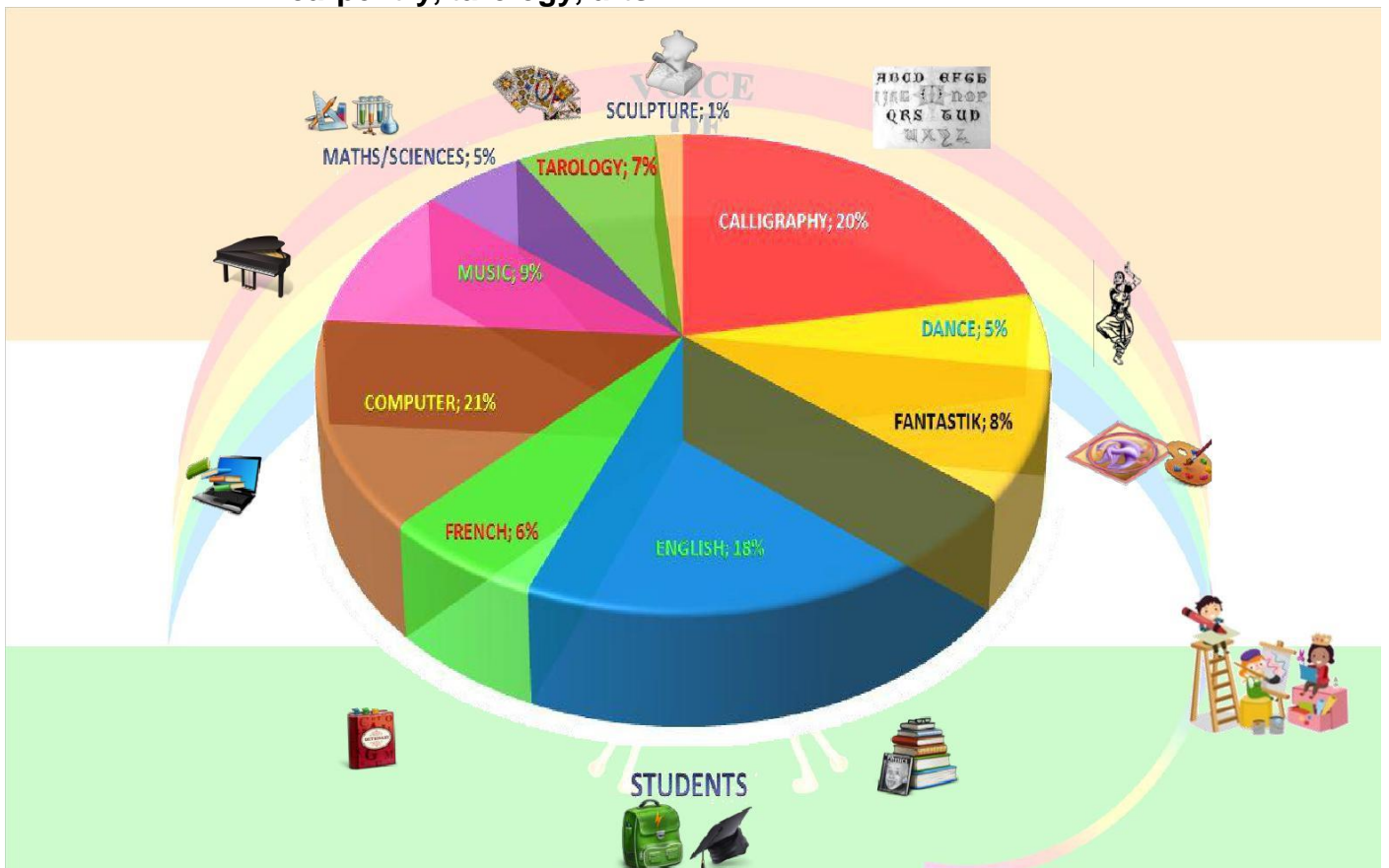

A budget of **55 800 ₹** has been invested for the purchase of miscellaneous equipment necessary for the proper functioning of the school, by both professors volunteer French URVASHI and ANANDA on their funds, without any help from the outside or us.

The average monthly cost of the school is **10 000 ₹** per month, including teaching materials, copies, painting, educational materials (WinS Program.).

Fees for aid and work in schools where they intervene is more or less **3 500 ₹** per month, with food, school supplies and various clothing that they distribute. All, funded by themselves, more a few donations of materials they receive directly for their schools.

Students who attended the school of the NGO for the lessons of coaching in various subjects school and extra-activities brought on average **1 000 ₹** per month immediately reinvested in various purchases for supplies and aid from our schools visited.

- Cleaning food vessels (used for Mid Day Meals)

**Toilet facilities that are**

- Gender-specific (i.e. separate for boys and girls), sufficient, child-friendly, adequate, well-equipped, well-maintained and culturally appropriate

**Hygiene promotion and education**

- Child cabinets, posters, wall-painting, messaging, events and competitions, community and household linkages
- Promote personal hygiene and school hygiene especially individual and group handwashing, nutritional supplements



They bring the teaching and visual material support and give to all needy students of hygienic equipment (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, oil for hair, comb,...).

In each class, where students have not yet fully English mastered, the teacher translates in Hindi.



Lessons on each theme last on average 45 minutes during which the students are required to participate in a game of questions and answers; thus pushing them to reflect on the different scenarios. They use external materials such as earth, stones, paper, which allow to better understand the graphic support presented, then children are viewing on microscopic particles invisible to the naked eye.

## **PROGRAM WinS (WASH in Schools)**

Learn how to strengthen the visual medium, paper and other accessories, by targeted examples specific to India and specifically in Rajasthan. Integrate the maximum pieces of information that can be used to supplement the subjects (ex: signals of danger on the packaging).

Refine the choice of videos of various media, synchronize them with the lessons of the program. Axe interactivity between program **WinS**, drawings, videos and educational support brought to each lesson.

Each month during the weekly visits in schools program will be treated as follows:

Week 1: The lesson during which the topic will be presented and developed in full.

Week 2: A drawing session based on the subject matter.

Week 3: A general discussion with practical examples, using educational materials, the replay of videos, passages to the blackboard, or by small groups of work by dividing the class around the subject.

An overview of the topic will be made at the end of the meeting for review.

Week 4: Exam on the topic of the month, in two parts:

1 - Oral question for each changing the questions every time.

2 - In blackboard passage to explain by the individual drawing what was taught.

The presence of the teacher is essential in the class where students don't understand English.

Implement sustainable program **WinS** in the current schools and those to come on the school year.

Teaching good manners and hygienic basics to the new generation, make him aware of the real dangers to the poor conditions of hygiene or bad behaviour sometimes endangering the lives of others.

Pass the message to younger allow to disseminate within families and little by little throughout a community, settlement or village.

The year 2015-16, schools that we visited have all been favourable to the continuity of the current programme. In some classes, the school wished that the program is finished with the major classes before the holidays.

The pedagogical work, the tricks to wake students in the interventions, is a challenge facing at each change of class. All react in the same way to approach more or less difficult to treat subjects.

Visual and educational materials are necessary for the proper performance of the lessons. Too many reading without animation becomes boring and you quickly lose the attention of students.

The costs for this program are minimal because the support is the same every time. Educational tools, some are everyday objects often thrown in the trash at the normal time (example: toothbrush used, old water bottles or other jars in the earth, plugs, earth, chalk,...).

# COMPUTER LESSON

The goal is to introduce students to the basics of the main programs of office automation and design such as Word, Excel, Publisher, Powerpoint and Paint.

In all schools where we have been for these courses, a review of this material will be made. Based on the results (older versions or obsolete equipment) we will come with our computers. We will put a minimum of 3 computers in place or will complete the number of computers already present on the spot.

## Paint program

This program will be offered to students who have not based on computer science. It will allow them through the drawing to make the first approach to the computing environment, how to use the mouse, different menus, and create a first personal document.

## Program Work

After the opening of the program, students will be guided to open a new document in which they begin by writing a few words in English (full name, class, address, family,...). Then pagination with fonts of colours and different sizes.

The next step will be to insert a WordArt or pictures (clip art or picture), from the Gallery of pictures that we provide also.

## Excel program

The first exercise will be to schedule the week of school in a table (days, lessons and time) and then will come the formatting with change font background colour of the frame with colours...

The next step will be setting up a table with figures such as notes or sports scores (cricket), to create graphics in various forms.

## Program Publisher

Freedom of choice will be left to the student to a personal grip. This program will allow him to create all kinds of documents, it will be able to see the various possibilities offered to them. The advice will be tailored to each case.

## Program Powerpoint

For the more seasoned the Powerpoint program will allow students to make more elaborate presentations and can them be used to prepare more complex presentations for a possible explanation on the topic to the class.

Each student will be followed and guided in a personal way on each case according to the software used in the lesson. At the end of each session, all students files will be saved for future use, on media removable and preserved by the Professor of the NGO.
