Our NGO working for vulnerable children and we extend our ability to support these children in improving their lives. We visit orphanages and we provide food, support equipment and bring to the artistic activities to develop their mind thereby improving the conditions and quality of life in these structures, and on it is the excitement!

During these visits, we take the time to listen to them talk about their daily needs for a better life, better education and greater attention. Our NGO helps manage themselves through primary basic education, giving them ways to opening for artistic activities such as painting, modelling, the music, singing, learning of the languages English, French, computer, writing, woodcarving, cabinetmaking, joinery building, that can give them responsibilities and initiatives outlets.

We desire to develop manual dexterity in creating objects and encourage personal labour of children. We provide assistance material, educational, clothes and games for everyone, and if necessary the means more sophisticated for the community.



. SONG AND POESY CLASS 1 TO 7 IN TAKSHAL SCHOOL .

In class :

- First, we read the poesy, we mime it on the whiteboard.
- We write on the copy and draw the moral with decoration.

The children are proud and they sing and learn with joy. It's very different following the classes. There is 5 sort of poesy's class.

1) Alphabet and Counting

It is a well-known fact that the techniques of learning build the strongest foundations in a child's formative year.

They can make our child a darling of everyone's eyes and what else would be the easiest way to teach these manners to our children then.























. CALLIGRAPHY CLASS .



Children learn how to decorate letters from the Middle Ages 12 ° to 14 ° century, Gothic writing, capital letters, and write their first names while decorating them.







. DRAWING CLASS .



Children learn different techniques, mirroring, graphics, groups, marrying colours according to themes: modern, 3D, different styles: psychedelic, modern, old and mandalas. Learn to draw without models.

Learning English allows my students to open their minds and be more active in life. 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. MANUALS ACTIVITIES .

Quilling: Make coloured pictures using strips of coloured paper rolled up on a hook and arranged according to the pattern.



Decoration: paper or wood support use of pearls, seeds, glitters, shells, various materials and folding.










Our areas of actions in India, in Rajasthan, in the districts of Udaipur and Jodhpur.

. ANNUAL FUNCTION IN TAKSHAL SCHOOL . 14 AVRIL 2019






What is a wonderful year, sharing joy, passion and emotions between the staff and developing our best wishes for our children in Takshal International School in Tinwari.





. PROGRAM WinS (WASH in Schools) .



Learn how to strengthen the visual medium, paper and other accessories, by targeted examples specific to India and specifically in Rajasthan. Integrate the maximum pieces of information that can be used to supplement the subjects (ex: signals of danger on the packaging).

Refine the choice of videos of various media, synchronize them with the lessons of the program. Axe interactivity between program WinS, drawings, videos and educational support brought to each lesson.

Each month during the weekly visits in schools program will be treated as follows:

Week 1: The lesson during which the topic will be presented and developed in full.

- Week 2: A drawing session based on the subject matter.
- Week 3: A general discussion with practical examples, using educational materials, the a replay of videos, passages to the blackboard, or by small groups of work by dividing the class around the subject.

An overview of the topic will be made at the end of the meeting for review.

- Week 4: Exam on the topic of the month, in two parts:
 - 1 Oral question for each changing the questions every time.
 - 2 In blackboard passage to explain by the individual drawing what was taught.

The presence of the teacher is essential in the class where students don't understand English.

Implement sustainable program WinS in the current schools and those to come on the school year.

Teaching good manners and hygienic basics to the new generation, make him aware of the real dangers to the poor conditions of hygiene or bad behaviour sometimes endangering the lives of others.

Pass the message to younger allow to disseminate within families and little by little throughout a community, settlement or village.

The year 2019, schools that we visited have all been favourable to the continuity of the current programme. In some classes, the school wished that the program is finished with the major classes before the holidays.

The pedagogical work, the tricks to wake students in the interventions, is a challenge facing at each change of class. All react in the same way to approach more or less difficult to treat subjects.

Visual and educational materials are necessary for the proper performance of the lessons. Too many reading without animation becomes boring and you quickly lose the attention of students.

The costs for this program are minimal because the support is the same every time. Educational tools, some are everyday objects often thrown in the trash at the normal time (example: toothbrush used, old water bottles or other jars in the earth, plugs, earth, chalk,...).

. COMPUTER LESSON .



Opening of an introductory class in the IT environment: Software and Hardware. What are a computer and multiple software used for occupation or leisure?



The goal is to introduce students to the basics of the main

programs of office automation and design such as Paint, Word, Excel, Publisher, and Powerpoint.



In all schools where we have been for these courses, a review of this material will be made. Based on the results (older versions or obsolete equipment) we will come with our computers. We will put a minimum of 3 computers in place or will complete the number of computers already present on the spot.

Program Paint

This program will be offered to students who have not based on computer science. It will allow them through the drawing to make the first approach to a computing environment, how to use the mouse, different menus, and create a first personal document.

W Program Word

After the opening of the program, students will be guided to open a new document in which they begin by writing a few words in English (full name, class, address, family,...). Then pagination with fonts of colours and different sizes.

The next step will be to insert a WordArt or pictures (clip art or picture), from the Gallery of pictures that we provide besides.

Program Excel



The first exercise will be to schedule the week of school in a table (days, lessons and time) and then will come the formatting with change font background colour of the frame with colours... The next step will be setting up a table with figures such as notes or sports scores (cricket), to create graphics in various forms.

Program Publisher

Freedom of choice will be left to the student to a personal grip. This program will allow him to create all kinds of documents, it will be able to see the various possibilities offered to them. The advice will be tailored to each case.

Program Powerpoint

For the more seasoned the Powerpoint program will allow students to make more elaborate presentations and can them be used to prepare more complex presentations for a possible explanation on the topic to the class.

Each student will be followed and guided in a personal way on each case according to the software used in the lesson. At the end of each session, all students files will be saved for future use, on media removable and preserved by the Professor of the NGO.

. CARPENTER CLASS AND WORK .







The carpentry class or workshop teaches the basics and techniques of carpentry work.

The Carpenter can have permanent work inside and outside the buildings. Whether to put a door, a window, a partition, shelves, benches, tables, beds, or any other furniture.

The craft can be learned on the job in 3 years or more if one adds the sculpture or woodturning, as I would teach in the future Wood Crafts Centre in Tinwari.












. CARPENTRY CLASS .



Here are the different stages of the manufacture of furniture, example table or bench which are offered to the student in the class of learning with all the necessary tools.



1. Rule plan:



This operation is to draw to scale 1 (actual size) the furniture to achieve a class table. The map should appear all the sides of the furniture: front view, side view, seen from above to see all of the pieces composing the book with the assemblies and finished size parts. Once the plan is completed, it allows meeting all sides of the pieces to make the flow map, with the marks of the school.

2. Flowsheet:

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This document brings together all the parts of a book with the flow ratings (cut before machining size), the sides finished (after processing), and information specific to each part of assemblies (mortise, tenon, groove, hardware...).

This spreadsheet allows to calculate the cubage of the individual parts, the material used (wood, plywood, chipboard, hardboard, laminate, glass,...), and to estimate the cost according to the use that they must do or the final price desired.

3. Tracing of wood:

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Using the flowsheet, all parts are drawn on planks of wood of different thicknesses depending on the sides. The sizes are increased by 1 Cm wide and 5-10 Cm in length. This allows getting rid of some defects like cracks or knots in the final cut.








4. Machining of wood:


First step cutting long pieces, then the widths. The next step is the establishment of the parts. This is to choose the most beautiful face of the part that will be visible on the finished piece of furniture outside. This established face bears the name of siding and is identified by a particular symbol on the plane on the rule.

























. THE WOODEN TRADES CENTRE .

The current project with the help of the SYLPHI FOUNDATION, of which I am one of the founding members since September 2018, is above all to open a TRAINING CENTRE FOR WOODWORK in Tinwari with European techniques adapted to Indian styles.










WOODTURNING









This training centre will allow me as a teacher trainer to share my knowledge with all those who would like to learn one of these trades of wood. Young people who wish to follow these technical studies of creative manual activities, coupled with theoretical courses will in future be able to transmit this knowhow and thus remain established in the village.

I bring all my know-how, my pedagogy, the supports of technology to discover their talent, to select their professional orientation best adapted to their taste or personality. Develop their manual dexterity, perfect their appreciation and awareness in the material and the architectural environment in which they live.

Acquire the notion of the time needed to complete a job whatever it is. The workshops give meaning to the training by the actual application of courses in geometry, calculations, drawing, compliance instructions, ribs, the use of machine tools, power tools and hand tools that capture their attention.

The professional and personal follow-up of my apprentices is my priority. According to the number of young people I would receive in training, after the execution of basic exercises to test their capacity and their interest, I would direct them to three distinct activities to diversify their chances of insertion shortly and avoid the number of labourers in a single activity at the local level. Give them responsibilities, teach them to trust them ...



I have also received applications from trainees applying for internships under the patronage of UNESCO.

This first month has been a good test for this extra – class. We had 44 students every day in two groups. One in English, one in Computer. Children are very interesting because in English they learn new methods (how to speak English easily), playing group, working their memory. They are also interesting by the Computer class seeing and touching all the hardware material on the computer.

We are very happy to continue this extra-class in Jagdamba School to Balarwa village. By our success, some parents asked us authorization to admit their children from other schools to come and join us in this extra-class.













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
